Greenland "Double Top" Expedition



In July 2007, Sagax scientific and environmental eco-science team, in cooperation with Green Cross International, will measure global warming impact on wildlife in the Arctic region of Greenland: Ivory Gull, polar bear, bowhead whale, lichen, etc...

We will also try to reach the Top of Greenland (Highest peak in the Arctic), a symbol of Greenland's shrinking ice-cap, while collecting lichen samples and censusing ivory gulls colonies in the peak's region.

Reach the Top of the World: the Northernmost point of land on earth (this area, rich in flora and fauna which will be analyzed and measured, is particularly sensitive to global warming).
